## Cub Scouts

2016 has been an amazing year; we have completed 38 Camps and Activities throughout the year! Well, done!! The biggest of those would of course had to have been Cuboree, Anzac Day Sleepover, NightHowl, Kokoda, Konrad the Magician, James the Scientist, Bowling, CCC, Air Factory, Father's Day Camp and Swimming! I hope you have some great stories to share with friends and family these Christmas Holidays.

2017 is shaping up to be a big year; we should have a camps and activities calendar available by January, dates may change but we are trying to give families as much notice as possible to aid in organisation. Our first camp will be on February 17th -19th at Brownsea Water Activities Centre (Redland Bay - Scout Run Site) where the cubs will be earning they're Canoeing Level One/Two Badge. The estimated cost will be \$80, but we will confirm this closer to the date. If your cub is interested, please let one of the leaders know so that they may be included in the numbers. Numbers are limited to 35 adults and cubs.

Next year around June we will be getting information on the 2018 Cuboree; this is a 5 night 6 day bi-annual camp for Cubs 9 years and older.... Estimated cost is approximately \$600, held during the September school Holidays. Fundraising opportunities are available for this event through Ashmore Dodgers BBQ Sausage Sizzles, every cub and parent are able to volunteer their time. Next time you see Woody around the Den ask him about it, I'm sure he will be happy to find a place on the roster to assist families in getting to Cuboree!!.
