CUB SCOUT PACK

Yolandi King will be known by the name Rama. Traditionally, Cub Scout Leaders take their names from Rudyard Kipling's *Jungle Book*. Rama is a water buffalo within the Jungle Book. Yolandi will be the Leader in Charge of the Pack.

Susan Anderson will be known by the name Rikki Tikki Tavi (Rikki for short). Rikki is a mongoose within the Jungle Book. Susan hails from New Zealand, where she grew up in the country, achieving agriculture certificates, and a Junior Merit Award for Young Farmer of the Year in 2013. Susan's mother was a Kea (Joey) Leader. Susan participated in Keas and Girl Guides, and was a Programme Activity Leader for Keas when she was fifteen. This involved working with the Leaders in their programme and helping out on meeting nights. Susan is now a childcare educator with a Diploma.

Steven Green will be known by the name Bagheera. Bagheera is a black panther within the Jungle Book. Steven is an Age Manager Nippers (Kurrawa), and has a Bachelor of Science (Geography) and Diploma of Business. Steven was a youth member in Scouting between 1975 and 1991 (Cubs to Rovers). Steven was awarded his Queens Scout Award, and was also an Assistant Scout Leader.

SCOUT TROOP

Leesa Kennedy will be known by the name Waikerie, which is Aboriginal for "many wings" or "bird with many wings". Leesa brings with her over 30 years' experience within the Girl Guide Association, and has camped over 600 nights under canvas. Leesa will be the Leader in Charge of our Scout Troop.
